## Pink Slip Day

Dear Families

This term we will continue to focus on the standards of uniform across the school. Following the success of last term's Pink Slip Day, and the clear improvement in uniform as a result of the day, we will be running the same initiative next week. This message will be reiterated by tutors in assemblies and via the Headteacher's message at the beginning of the week. Students will receive a warning initially at the beginning of the week about this day, so that they have the opportunity to correct their uniform in advance of it.

Students will have at least one day next week where they will be asked to stay behind after school for 20 minutes if they are not adhering to the correct uniform expectations. Please be aware that students must wear both their lanyard and student ID card as part of their full school uniform. We have seen a recent increase in students not wearing their lanyards or ID cards, which poses both a safeguarding issue and also considerably slows service in the canteen. If your child needs a new lanyard or ID card in preparation for next week, these can be purchased and collected from Student Services. Payments will need to be made with cash. It is £1.50 for the lanyard and £1.50 for the card.
