Orleans Park Sixth Form has organised for all students in Year 12 to attend a driving safety presentation called 'Safe Drive, Stay Alive'.

'Safe Drive, Stay Alive' is an emotionally engaging and thought provoking theatre-based education production, coordinated by Surrey Fire & Rescue Service, which aims to raise road safety awareness amongst young people and positively influence their attitudes to driving. This will form part of the students' PSHE programme. As many of the Year Group are now of driving age and may be taking lessons, the aim is to make them more aware of the responsibilities of being a road user, the potential dangers of driving and being a passenger in a car with other young drivers.

The trip will take place on Thursday 10 November, leaving school at 11.00am and travelling to Dorking Halls by coach. There is a small cost of £5.00 to cover the coach hire and a donation to the Fire Service.
