Year 11 Easter Revision Sessions

Dear Families

In order to support Year 11 students further with their GCSE revision, we will be running revision sessions for students over the Easter break. Sessions will be held from Monday 3 April to Thursday 6 April (with an additional day on Tuesday 11 April) between 9.00am and 12.20pm. Attached to this letter is a timetable of these sessions. Please make sure you and your son or daughter carefully check which topic areas will be covered in the different revision sessions, as some subjects will be repeating the same session 3 times in a day (e.g. English, Maths and Science).

Once you have looked at the timetable, please register your son or daughter, as students must be signed up to attend. Each session will have capacity for 29 students, so places will be offered on a first come first served basis. Please be aware that in previous years places have been filled extremely quickly.

Once the registers for the revision sessions have been finalised, we will be asking those students attending to pay a one off voluntary contribution of £50, in order to cover the significant cost of running these sessions. This can be done via ParentPay and is a similar price to what an individual tutor would charge for an hour. Any Pupil Premium students or students in receipt of Free School Meals do not need to pay this charge, but must still register for the revision sessions online. Only once students have signed up to the revision sessions and we have confirmed the registers will we ask for payment, not before
